1. 科目の概要 (Course Description)

How is culture acquired and how does it affect the way we act, think, and feel? How does switching cultures affect our thinking and identity, especially during the formative years? Through focusing on children reared and educated outside the culture of their parents (Third Culture Kids/Returnees), we will see how entering or readjusting to a culture affects us, especially in forming identity.

The first semester we will study Third Culture Kids in depth, and during the second semester we will read stories written by Third Culture Kids who have become writers. Please buy both textbooks in advance as they take time to acquire.

Students will be expected to participate actively through their presentations and through discussions. In addition, they will be asked to write papers on topics related to culture and identity.
